To close down certain cycles and sectors in some private schools for the 2023-2024 school year for the violation of legal procedures relating to expansion

### THE MINISTER OF SECONDARY EDUCATION.

#### HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: The following private schools or teacher training colleges are hereby closed down from the date of signature of this order in accordance with the provisions of Article 12 of law no. 2004/022 of 22 July 2004 and of Articles 31 and 32 of decree no. 2008/3043/ PM of 15 December 2008:
